85 Data Centers Consolidating in 3 U.S. Cities

Hewlett-Packard Co. said it would consolidate its 85 data centers around the world into six large facilities in the United States, aiming at \$1 billion (U.S.) in annual savings.

HP said that after the consolidation, its information technology infrastructure would be run from Atlanta, Houston and Austin, TX, with two facilities in each city.

Part of the gain from the move will come from utility cost savings of up to 25 percent.

The data center sites were chosen based on the costs of the space, the available power and network connections, as well as lower vulnerability to natural disasters, the company said.
